

THE PIG-near Bath - Walk 2

To the pub and back!

Approx. 4.6 miles
(100 mins, 50 mins each way)



Walk down the drive and turn left down the road and walk for approx. 10 minutes. Walk past the red phone box, down the lane you will see a track opposite Hunstrete Cottage which leads to a public footpath to your left leading to a field. Go through the gate with the weight on. Walk straight down the hill then through the kissing gate to another track and turn left. The building on your right is Wick Farm.

Follow the track all the way along to the yellow road on your map. Go right following the road along until you see a break in the hedge line on your right which leads into a field. Go straight ahead across the field to the metal gate and go through the woods over the bridge and up the hill breaking into the next field.

Head straight across the field, up the hill to the next gate and go left following the track along. This is Allens Brake. Stay in this field and keep walking along the edge of the field until you get to the entrance of the field next to the tip of the woods turn right through the break in the hedge and go left heading down a small hill towards the metal gate and go through this then turning right following the field along. This is Compton Green.

You will see ahead of you barns and houses. Straight ahead and slightly to the right of the field you will see a gate which will lead you along a track. You will have a barn on your right, keep going straight ahead until you get to the road which is the yellow road on your map.

Stop off at The Compton Inn for a refreshing drink by turning left on to the road and following this for 5 minutes. The Compton Inn will be on your left.

Once you are nicely refreshed turn left out of The Compton Inn, walking past the Compton Dando Village Hall. To your left you will see a wooden bridge that you need to go across then follow

the track until you break out into a field. This is Compton Green.

Head towards the left hand side of the field following the edge along heading towards the woods. Keep going until you reach the gate in the corner of the field and go through.

Continue straight with the woodland on your right and go through the gap in the hedge which will also be on your right. Turn left down the field and follow the path. This is Allens Brake.

Once at the top of the field you will come to a crossroads of gates take the right one and head over the hill. Go through the gate and into the woods. Make your way down the hill, over the bridge, up the hill and through the gate into the field, heading straight over.

Head through the gate which is to the left of the large tree in the field and make your way through the break in the hedge which takes you onto the road where you need to turn left.

When you get to a sharp right bend take the public footpath, going over the cattle grid and following the concrete path.

You will go past a house on your right, keep going until you pass a barn and see the no entry sign. You are now at Wick Farm. At this point go through the gate on your right hand side, and across the field to the next kissing gate and go straight up the field.

The views are stunning once at the top. Then through the kissing gate with the weight on.

Follow yellow arrow round to the right towards the road. Hunstrete Cottage will be straight ahead. Take a left at the road which takes you in to Hunstrete. It will take you approx. 10 minutes along the road before you are back at THE PIG

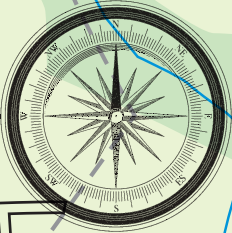
